

## About, 'Victory over Fear' (Pg.#2)

**Continuing in Psalm 27...**

**(Vs.10)** When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.

-- **Q9. Vs.10 is a bit of a shocking statement of David's faith because it says that...**

- a/ God wants us to be abandoned by our parents.
- b/ even if our parents forsake us, God won't.

**(Vs.11)** Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies. (12) Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.

-- **Q10. Here we find that when our enemies sow confusion and lies, what should we ask of God?**

- a/ To destroy our enemies.
- b/ To find us a place to hide.
- c/ For God to teach us how to overcome.

**(Vs.13)** I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

-- **Q11. What keeps King David 'alive and kicking'?**

- a/ He believed in God's goodness.
- b/ He believed he would overcome his troubles.
- c/ both a & b.

**(Vs.14)** Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

**And so ends this SONG OF KING DAVID...**

-- **Q12. What is the message that King David is trying to communicate to you and I?**

a/ Sometimes God's timing is not to our liking, we need to by faith wait to see God's deliverance.

b/ When God's timing seems long, if we courageously wait on Him, He will give us the strength to wait.

c/ both a & b.

**As stated before, God's house for us is His presence.** We are able to live day by day in the security of His Tabernacle, His presence is able to remove all FEAR of the future, and of the attacks of the enemy.

-- **We find the proof of this in 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 6:19-20 (GNB)** Don't you know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and who was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourselves but to God; (20) he bought you for a price. So use your bodies for God's glory.

-- Therefore as a born-again Christian, you can walk boldly before all men without fear, for as you follow God, He walks with you. ... (KK)
